FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT

This **FIRST AMENDMENT** ("First Amendment") is effective as of the last date signed by either party ("First Amendment Effective Date") and amends and supplements that certain Contract by and between Securus Technologies, LLC ("Securus") and the State of Oklahoma Department of Corrections ("ODOC") effective as of February 24, 2020 (the "Contract").

WHEREAS, ODOC and Securus are parties to the Contract and desire to amend the terms as stated herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, as of the First Amendment Effective Date and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Term.</u> This First Amendment shall commence on the last date signed by either party and shall remain in effect through the term of the Contract. The parties hereby agree to renew the Contract for an additional year, resulting in a new termination date of February 24, 2022. By mutual consent of the parties hereto, it is intended that there shall be eight remaining annual options to renew, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract and herein.
- 2. <u>Clarification of eMessaging Pricing</u>. The SERVICE OR PRODUCT RATES/CHARGES chart on Page 63 of the Contract is hereby removed and replaced as follows:

3. <u>Deployment of Securus Wireless Devices and Network</u>. With the deployment of wireless devices, the content available to the inmate population will be expanded through the offering of additional media formats as well as, a wider range of price points within each format. Pages 67 - 69 of the Contract are hereby removed and replaced as follows.

	Securus will provide a Securus Wireless Device to all ODOC approved end users. The Securus Wireless Device offers access to a variety of content, some of which is accessible at no cost and some of which is rented by the end user, including but not limited to eBooks, educational, religious, and vocational materials, songs, games, movies, podcasts, and television episodes. The Securus Wireless Device also offers access to other Securus services, such as telephone service and eMessaging.

	Securus will also provide ODOC designated staff with Securus command and control wireless devices for the purpose of management and control when using the Securus Wireless Devices. Securus grants end users a limited license to use the Securus Wireless Devices and content as contemplated by the Contract during the term of the Contract, but all Securus Wireless Devices and content will remain under the ownership of, as applicable, Securus or its licensors.
Scale and scope of solution	Securus will provide a Securus Wireless Device to all ODOC approved end users at all ODOC facilities within the scope of the Contract. Securus will deploy secure wireless networks as needed to support the provision of the Securus Wireless Devices. ODOC will own any wiring and network cable associated with this installation; however, any other infrastructure will be owned by Securus.

WIRELESS DEVICES AND NETWORK

Securus will provide a Securus Wireless Device to all ODOC approved end users. The Securus Wireless Device offers access to a variety of content, some of which is accessible at no cost and some of which is rented by the device user, including but not limited to eBooks, educational, religious, and vocational materials, songs, games, movies, podcasts, and television episodes. The Securus Wireless Device also offers access to other Securus services, such as telephone service and eMessaging. Securus will also provide ODOC designated staff with Securus Command and Control wireless devices for the purpose of management and control when using the Securus Wireless Devices.

Securus will deploy secure wireless networks as needed to support the provision of the Securus Wireless Devices. After the initial disbursement of Securus Wireless Devices to end users, ODOC will manage the supply of wireless devices; collecting wireless devices, cases, chargers, and earbuds from discharging inmates and re-issuing them to new incoming inmates. Securus will maintain a stock of earbuds at the facility for reissuing of tablets. Facility POC will request as needed. Earbuds will be issued at no cost to inmate only when issued at the time of tablet issuance.

ODOC will decommission any wireless devices, cases, chargers, and earbuds that become damaged, inoperable, or lost due to normal wear and tear. Securus will supply replacements for decommissioned wireless devices, cases, chargers, and earbuds as requested by ODOC at no cost to ODOC or end users. End users found to have purposely or maliciously damaged a device will be subject to disciplinary action and/or financial penalties as defined by ODOC policy.

Securus will offer an incentive for individuals to migrate from their existing MP3 player to the Securus wireless device as specified in Attachment B2. This incentive is not only intended to recognize the potential loss of content when migrating from the current MP3 player to the Securus device but is also intended to provide an incentive to discover access to new content and programing services that are currently not available.

- 4. Free Call Program. Since August 2020, in conjunction with ODOC's Covid relief efforts, Securus has been offering two ten-minute phone calls per week to each inmate at no cost to the inmate or ODOC. The visitation at ODOC facilities continues to be impacted by the Covid pandemic and relief efforts are ongoing. Both parties recognize and agree to the importance of continuing to provide this offering to the inmate population. With this amendment, Securus shall continue to offer two free ten-minute phone calls per week to each inmate without interruption until February 24, 2022, provided that the free call program may be terminated by mutual agreement of the parties. These free calls will not be commissionable and, if the free phone calls are not used during that week, the end user will not retain such free calls for that account whenever the next distribution of free phone calls occurs. Beginning on February 25, 2021, to coincide with the contract renewal period, ODOC shall share the cost of the free call program by reimbursing Securus monthly in arrears at a rate of \$0.09875 per minute based on actual minutes used during the free calls each month. Securus shall invoice ODOC each month to include a report of the call details to support the charges. Invoices shall be submitted via email to Toni Halferty at toni.halferty@doc.ok.gov.
- 5. ODOC Options for Alternative Compensation Structures. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Contract, at ODOC's option, ODOC may request that compensation and rates under the Contract be amended to either a no commission or taxpayer-funded and no commission option at any time during the term of the Contract. If requested by ODOC, the parties will negotiate in good faith regarding an appropriate reduction to the applicable call rates if ODOC agrees to no longer receive any commission or other type of financial compensation under the Contract. For such compensation structures, Securus can also accommodate an ODOC request to transition from end user funding of telephone services to a model where those services are taxpayer-funded / paid for by ODOC.
- 6. Except as expressly amended by this First Amendment, all of the terms, conditions and provisions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.
