Use of TruVision Navigator and System Compatibility

I. <u>Usage Guide for TruVision Navigator</u>

A. Live Video

Expand the facility folder. Double click the camera. The camera will display live video in the viewer.

B. <u>Video Playback</u>

Use the timeline bar at the bottom of the screen or click the calendar icon in the bottom right corner of the screen to go to a specific time. If this time is within the recording history of the device, it will display the requested video. DVRs can have up to two weeks of recording time.

C. <u>Video Export</u>

On the timeline bar, move the bookend icons to select the time frame for export. Click the film icon in the bottom right corner of the screen to collect the video in the collector. Once the clip is in the collector, click on the share icon (square with arrow pointing out). Choose location to export the video file. The export will include the video player application with it as well.

II. System Compatibility

TruVision Navigator is compatible with Windows computers running Windows 7 or above. The capability and age of the computer running the TruVision application will dictate how many simultaneous cameras can be streamed from the DVR at the same time.
