Food Service Apprenticeship completion certificate-90

- Skill Level 1** 12-week probation period, thereafter may become an apprentice, skilled pay scale applies.
- Skill Level 2:** Accomplish skill development in all areas of food service, apprentice skilled pay scale applies.
- Skill Level 3:** fulfilling the responsibilities of apprentice cooks and bakers, skilled pay scale applies.
- Skill Level 4:** Journeyman role in the food service industry, journeyman skilled pay scaled applies.
- Skill Level 5:** Culinarian; program completion, exercising competencies in all areas of food service as a professional, journeyman skilled pay scale applies.

Food Service Apprenticeship follows requirements of the Department of Labor apprenticeship guidelines and equates to over 24 months (960+ hours) of training.
