MEDICAL ACUITY REFERENCE GUIDE

MEDICAL ACUITY	Medical Acuity
Normal physical condition or mild disease (compensated medical condition)	MAA
Moderate (may require more frequent visits)	MAB
Severe (requires frequent monitoring, illness exacerbations, referral to specialty care, infirmary or hospital base care)	MAC

DISCRETIONARY OVERRIDE TO SPECIFIC FACILITY WHERE ALLOWED BY SECURITY LEVEL	Group
No override recommendations	O
W/C Bound (non-ambulatory)	WB
W/C (able to ambulate short distances without assistance)	W
Requires: Handicap accommodations	H
Pregnancy	P
Chronic hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis	D
TB disease: needs isolation cell at Infirmary	TB
Blind	BL
Requires inmate caregiver 1	CA1
Requires inmate caregiver 2	CA2
Restricted to current facility	CF
Requires infirmary care	INF
Requires facility with medical staff on-site 24 hours a day	NC
Requires facility with on-site medical care – No Halfway Houses - (CWCCC, UCCC, NOCC do not have supervised pill lines)	OMC
No private prisons	NP
MH-B1: NO county jail placement (exception – can go to exiting facility)	MHB1
MH-B2: NO county jail placement. Recommend override to facilities with one or more QMHP and weekly psychiatric visits. (exception – can go to exiting facility)	MHB2
MH-C1: NO county jail placement. Should have mental health staff approval for other than medium or maximum security.	MHC1
MH-C2: NO county jail placement. Meets criteria for Habilitation Program: Recommend JHCC or MBCC	MHC2
MH-D: NO county jail placement. Recommend MHU at JHCC, or MBCC	MHD
