CHECKLIST for PROBABLE CAUSE HEARING

Review Notice of Probable Cause Hearing, parole violation report(s), and any attachments.
Assemble hearing participants and turn on tape recorder.
Identify hearing by offender's name and ODOC number, case number(s), county, date, time, and place of hearing.
Identify hearing officer, offender (and attorney), state's representative, and witnesses or other parties.
Explain purpose of hearing and how it will proceed.
Exclude potential witnesses if necessary.
Hear any procedural objections.
State allegations as listed on Notice of Probable Cause Hearing.
Note offender's admission or denial of each allegation.
Allow the state's representative to present evidence and witnesses, with cross examination.
Inform offender of existence of any confidential information.
Allow the offender to present evidence and witnesses, with cross-examination.
Determine if evidence supports Notice of Finding of Probable Cause.
Announce decision to offender.
Explain executive revocation hearing and waiver.
Terminate hearing.

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
