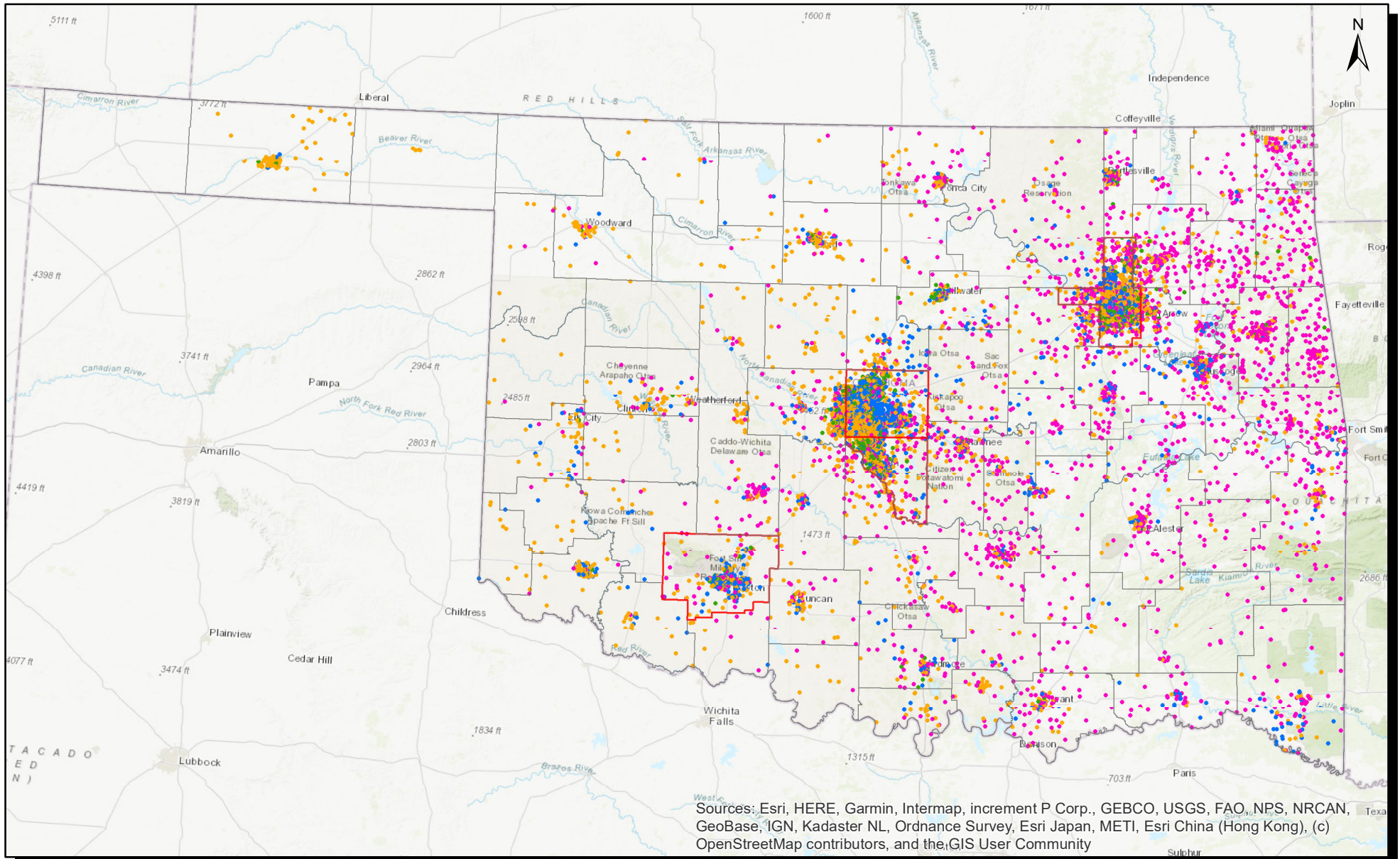

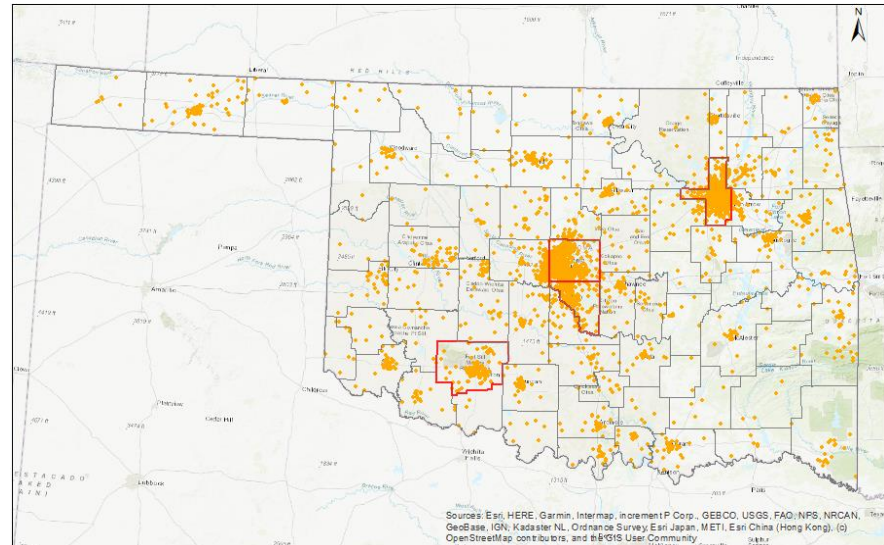
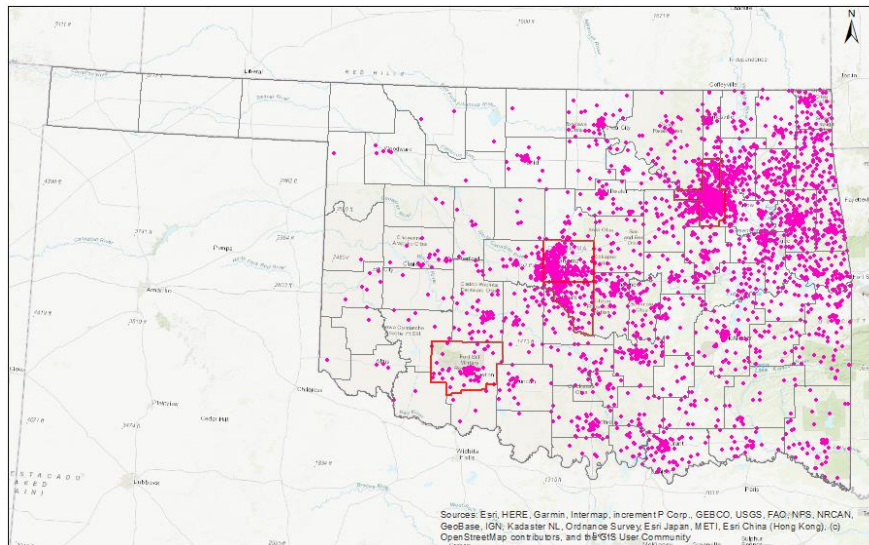
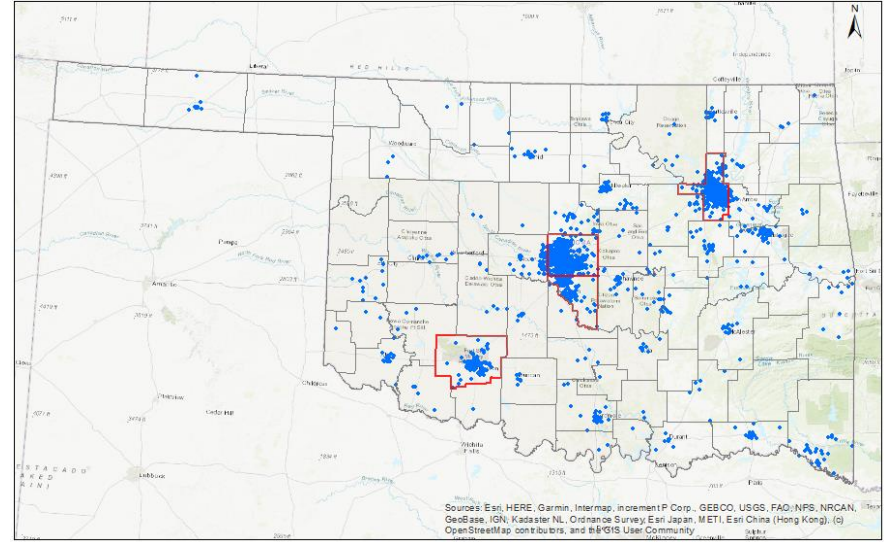
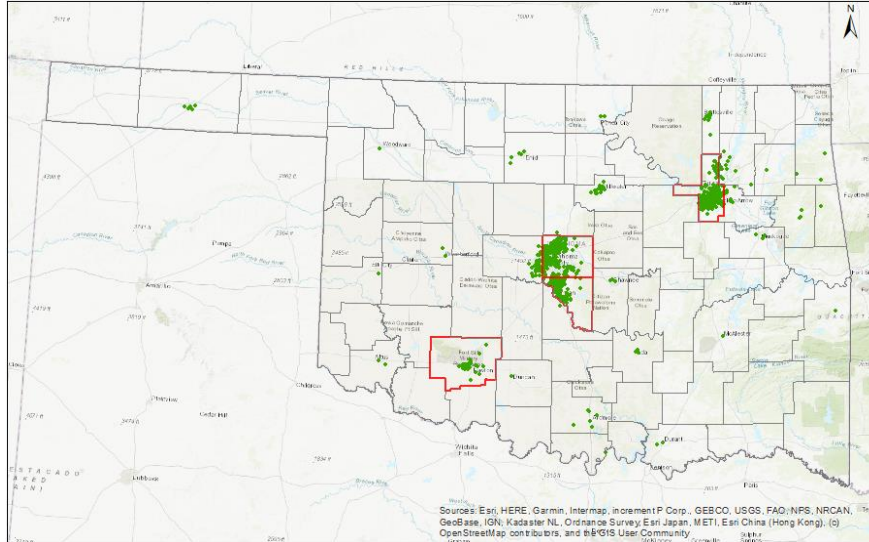

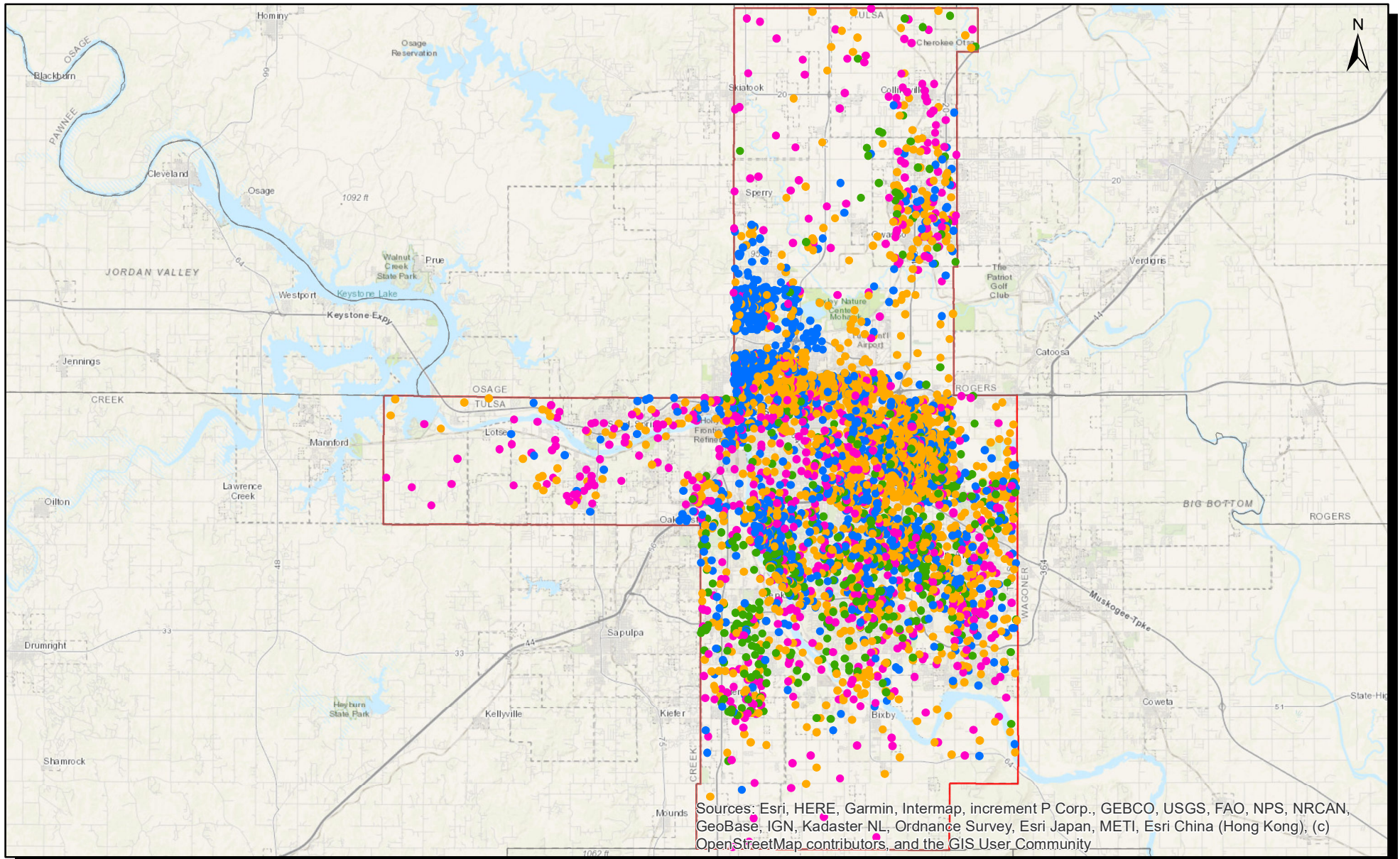
Geographic Distribution of Minority Population – State



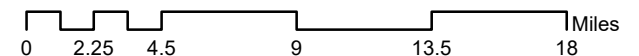

Geographic Distribution of Minority Population - Tulsa County

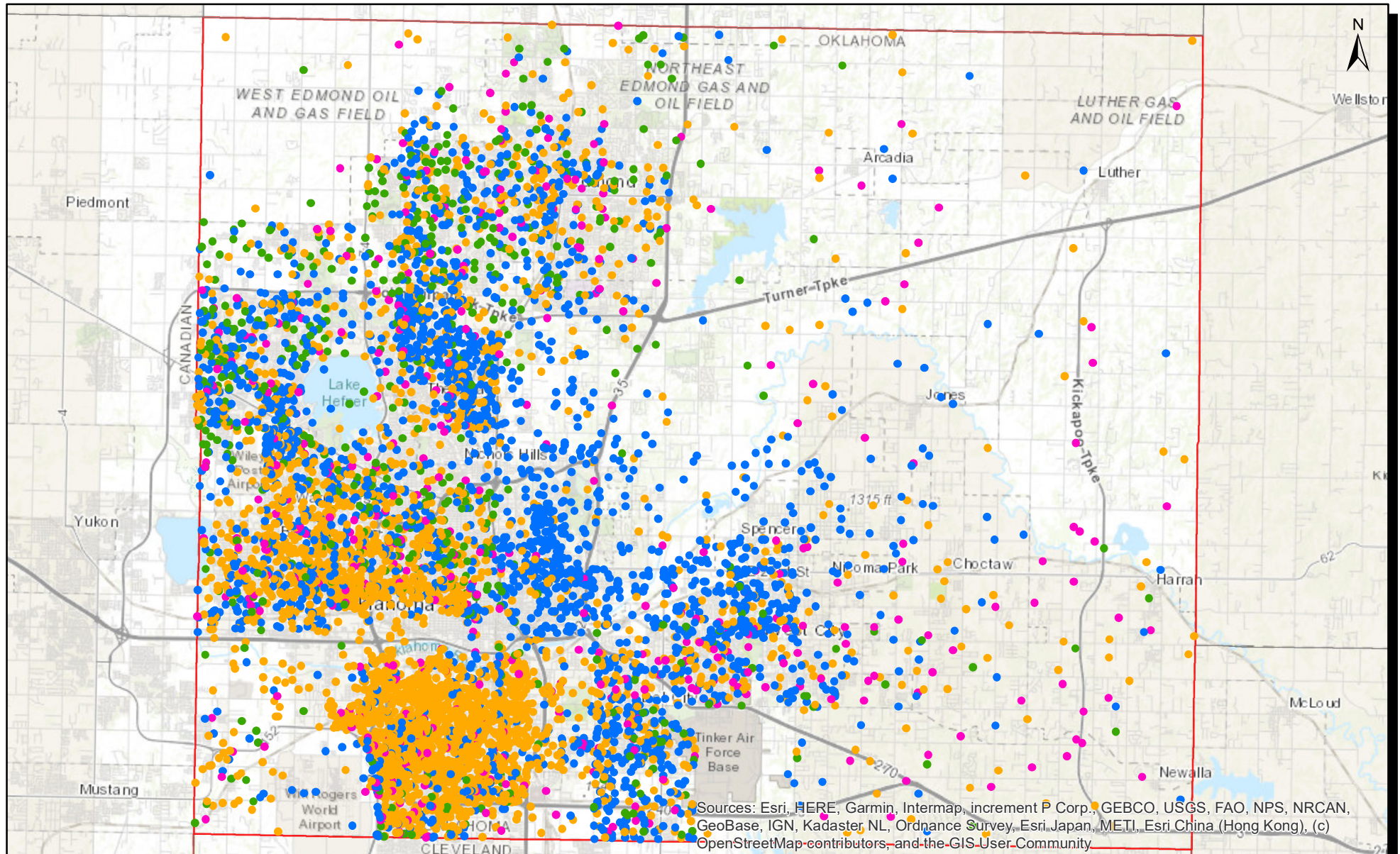

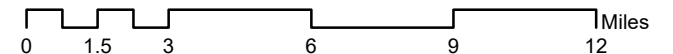

Geographic Distribution of Minority Population - Oklahoma County

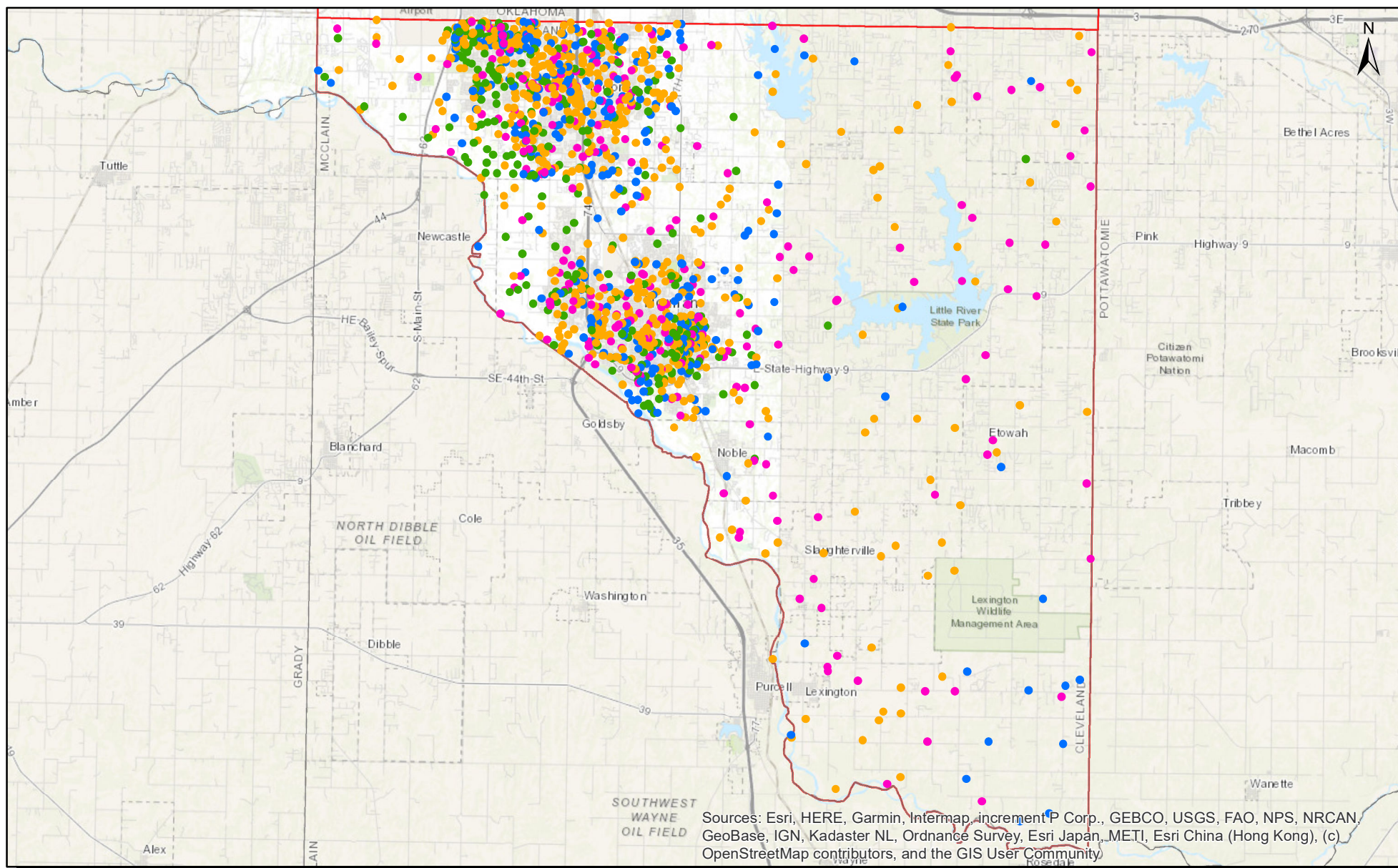

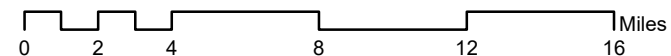

Geographic Distribution of Minority Population - Cleveland County

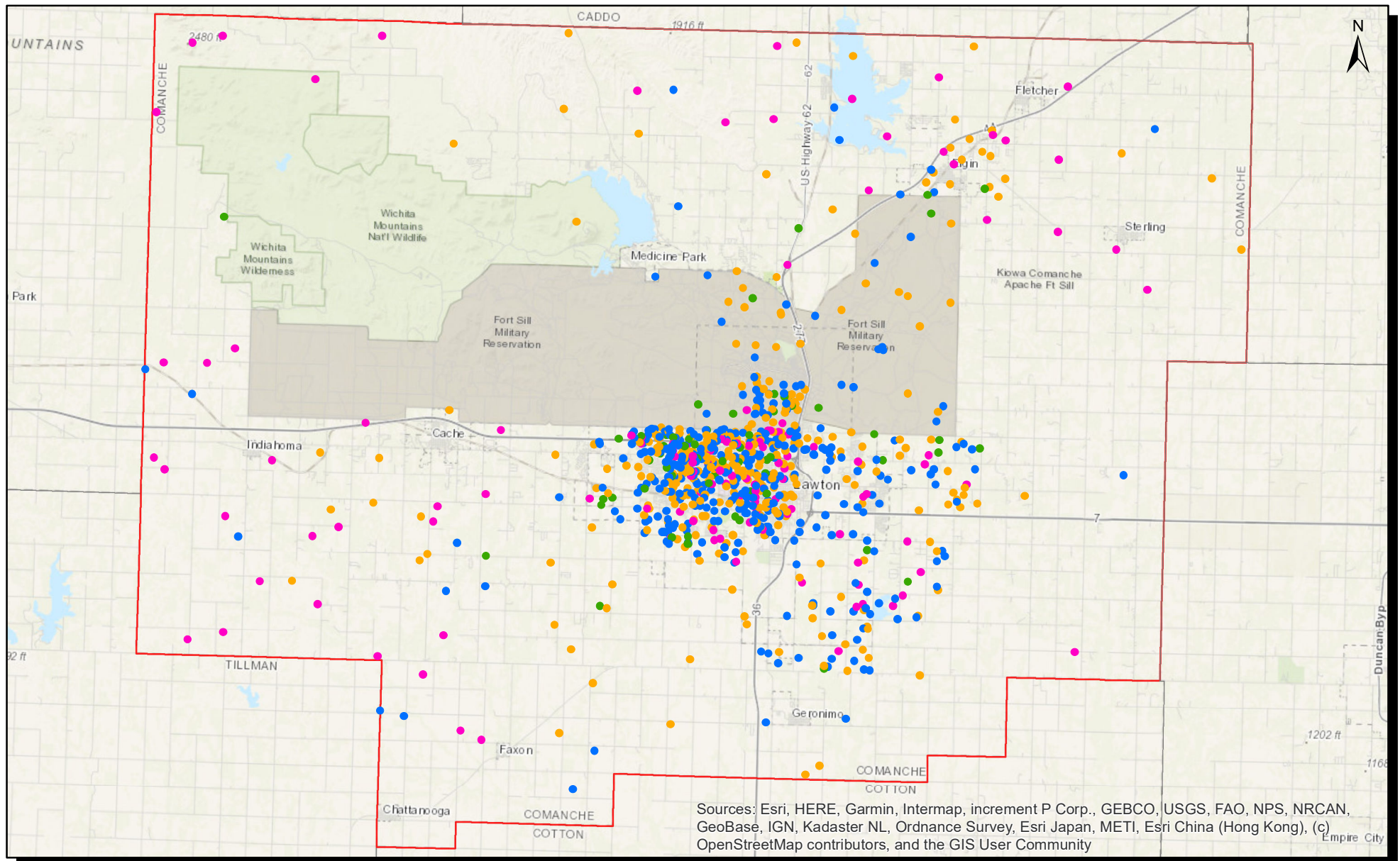

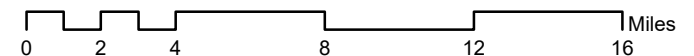
