Minutes

The meeting notice was filed with the Oklahoma Secretary of State on December 13, 2021 at 11:04 a.m. The meeting notice/agenda was posted on the Oklahoma State Department of Health website for the Region 7 RTAB on Friday, October 13, 2022 at 4:15 p.m.

- I. Call to Order......Theresa Compos, Chair The meeting was called to order at 1:01 p.m. by Chair Theresa Compos.

V. Reports

Emergency Systems.......Dean Henke, OSDH Mr. Henke provided staffing updates and let Tessa McCleary-Smith introduce herself as our newest EMS Administrator II. Dr. Yang Wan is no longer with our department. Open positions are an EMS Administrator II, an Epidemiologist II/III, and a Statistician. Initial EMS Ambulance inspections are still being conducted at NE 27th/ Stiles by the State Capital and you can schedule your inspection on our website. Mr. Henke reported the deadlines the Hospital Trauma Fund Application Deadline is November 30, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. and the EMS/Physician Trauma Fund Application Deadline is December 15, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. Trauma Fund Application Training for Physicians is scheduled for November 9, 2022 and for EMS is November 16, 2022. For Trauma Registry the Hospital Standards for licensure, Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 310:667-59-1(b) requires Oklahoma licensed hospitals to submit trauma cases meeting inclusion criteria monthly. These cases must be entered into the Trauma Registry by the last weekday of the month following when care was rendered. For example, April cases are due the last weekday of May. Mr. Henke reported that the trauma data from hospitals is not up to date so that can affect the data that is being requested. EMResource needs the contact number to be the emergency department phone number, then the Emergency Department manager, and last the hospital transfer number. Mr. Henke reported



that EMS agencies need to keep their OKEMSIS data up to date. OTERAC last meeting was October 11, 2022 and dates for 2023 were approved. Also the meetings will alternate between OKC and Tulsa. The next meeting will be held on February 1, 2023, at 1:00 pm in Tulsa. James O Goodwin Health Center, Tulsa City-County Health Department, 5051 South 129th East Avenue, Tulsa, OK 74134. Chris Dew reported at the last OTERAC meeting they discussed and voted to remove Chapter 642 which addressed the Oklahoma Emergency Response System Stabilization and Improvement Revolving Fund, vote to approve Chapter 643 s the new language that supports the Oklahoma Emergency Response System Stabilization and Improvement Revolving Fund Distribution. (Chapter OAC 310:643), vote to approve Chapter 645 Emergency Service District Supplemental Regulations. (Chapter OAC 310:645), and vote to approve Oklahoma trauma system assessment by the American College of Surgeon, or other entities pending availability of funding. Jeremy McLemore shared that the scoring has changed for agencies for applying for the Oklahoma Emergency Response System Stabilization and Improvement Revolving Fund grants hopefully allowing more agencies to apply instead of the same agencies being selected over and over. Mr. Dew reported the OERSSIRF reviews were completed on October 6, 2022 and announcements will be coming in the near future. Mr. Dew also shared about Oklahoma Trauma Education Program training will be held on Wednesday October 26, 2022 – 9:00 a.m. at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Training Center.
