- CMS Requirements for LTC Services/Surveyors
 - Federal Monitoring Surveys of survey teams (CMS will review no less than 5% of surveys completed for NF/SNFs)
 - Resource and Support Surveys (RSS)
 - Focused Concern Surveys (FCS)
 - Comparative Surveys
- Areas of Focused Concerns (next section) are specific items that CMS is closely reviewing

- Nurse Staffing
 - F851: Payroll Based Journal
 - F725: Sufficient Nurse Staffing
 - F727: RN 8 Hrs/7days/WK, Full Time DON
- Unnecessary Psychotropic Medications
 - F641: Accuracy of Assessments
 - F658: Services Provided Meet Professional Standards
 - F758: Free from Unnecessary Psychotropic Meds/PRN Use
- Facility-Initiated Discharge
 - F622 Transfer and Discharge Requirements
 - F624: Preparation for Safe/ Orderly Transfer/Discharge
 - F626: Permitting Residents to Return to Facility
