

SFY 2017 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

August Invoice Report

Of the 20 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 12 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 12 FQHCs, 8 submitted invoices, and of these 8, only 3 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.

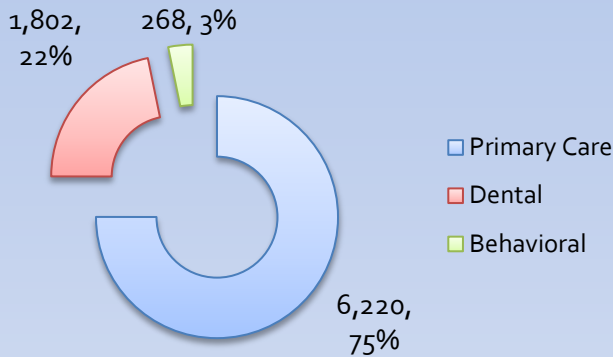

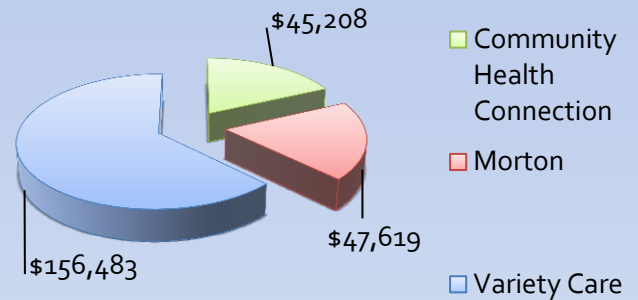

Uncompensated Care Costs (UCC)



For services provided in August, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 1,018 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$249,312.07

Total UCF Available = \$192,882.16

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 77.36% of their requested reimbursement amount.
