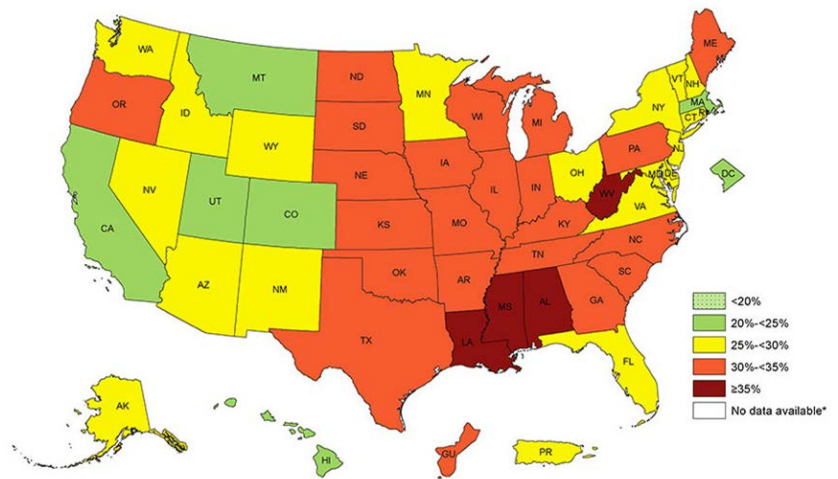

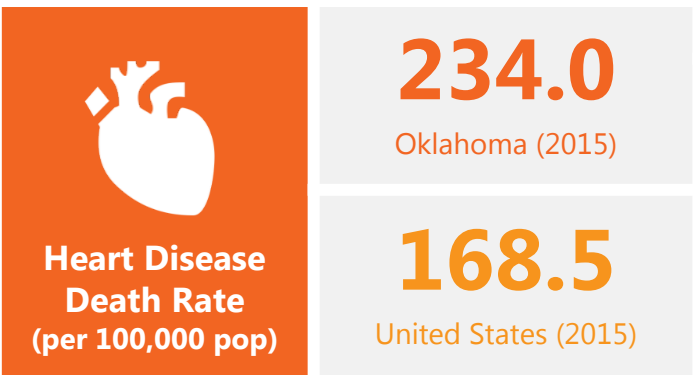

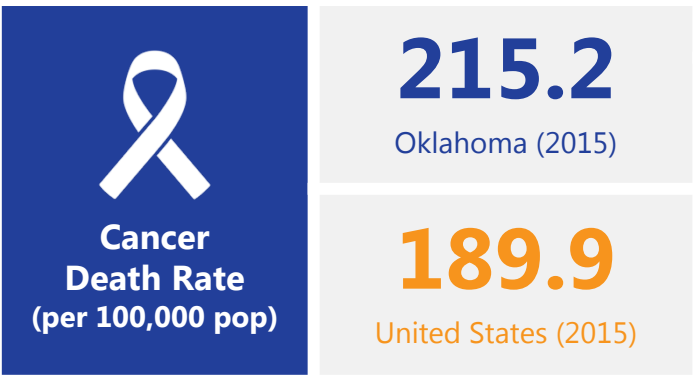
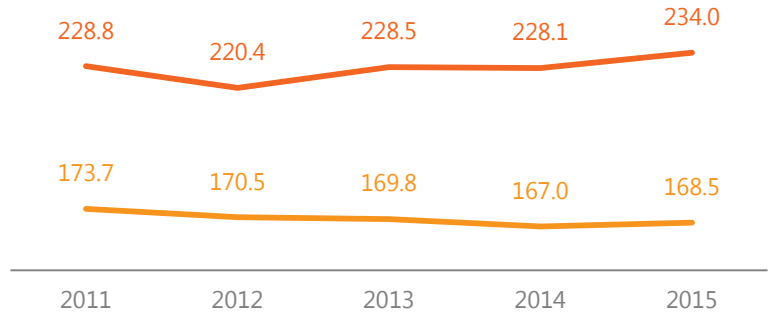
Obesity-Related Chronic Conditions



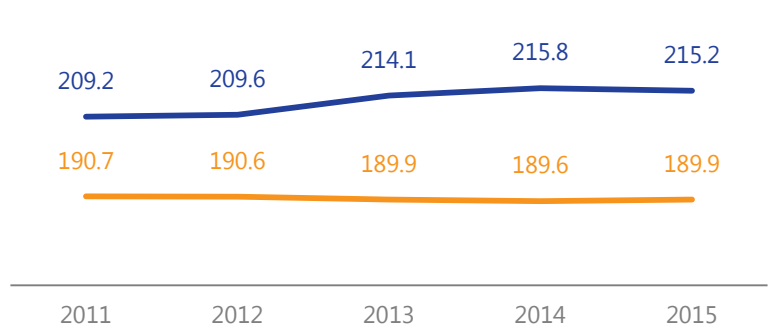
Oklahoma has the 9th highest diabetes prevalence

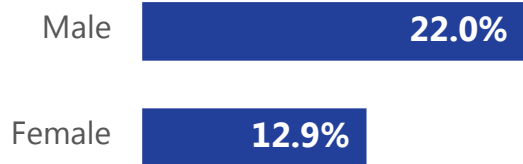
