

# SFY 2015 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

## March Invoice Report

Of the 19 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 14 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 14 FQHCs, 8 submitted invoices, and of these 8, only 4 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.

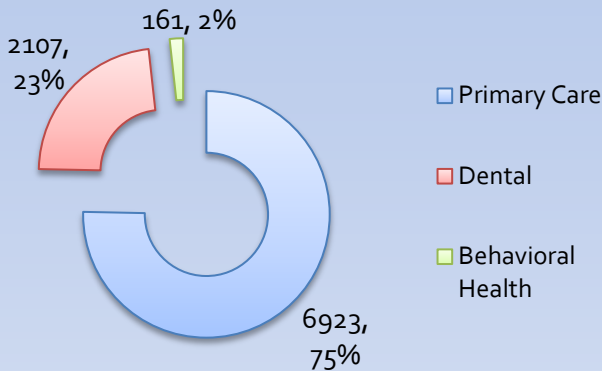

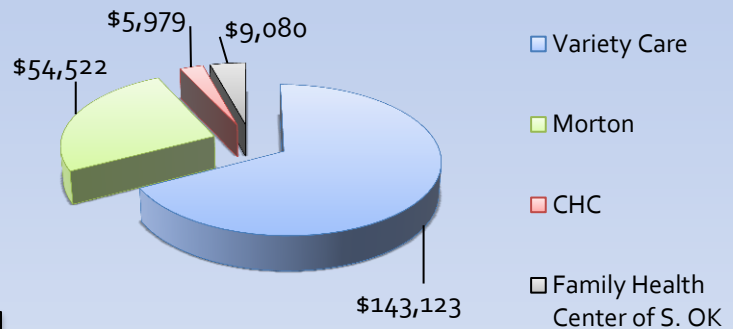

### UCF Reimbursement



For services provided in March, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 1,270 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$314,355.72

Total UCF Available = \$212,706.41

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 67.66% of their requested reimbursement amount.
