

SFY 2016 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

March 1-8 Invoice Report

Of the 20 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 15 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 15 FQHCs, 3 submitted invoices, and of these 3, all 3 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance. This month had a reduced allocation of \$54,899.52 and is the last month for the uncompensated care fund.

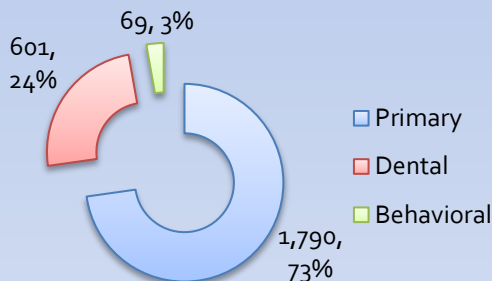

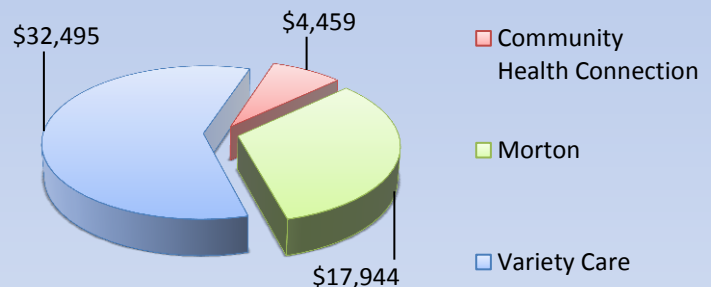

UCF Reimbursement



For services provided between March 1 and March 8, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 293 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$217,636.24

Total UCF Available = \$54,899.52

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 25.22% of their requested reimbursement amount.
