Whereas, Oklahomans should use every means to improve their health; and

Whereas, a family health history (the list of health disorders of family members living and dead) can lead to preventative measures to maintain health or to early diagnosis for proper treatment; and

Whereas, a thorough family history is best collected with information from as many family members as possible; and

Whereas, end of year holidays beginning with Thanksgiving week, is a time for family gatherings; and

Whereas, the U.S. Surgeon General has declared Thanksgiving 2005 as National Family Health History Day; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma Genetics Advisory Council of the Oklahoma State Department of Health endorses this effort and urges all Oklahomans to take advantage of their family gatherings to develop a family history;

Now, therefore, I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim November 21 - 27, 2005, as

"Oklahoma Family Health History Week"

in the State of Oklahoma.
