Dear Member,

Welcome to Soon-to-be-Sooners (STBS). The Oklahoma Health Care Authority wants to tell you about your benefits to help you get the best care for your unborn baby.

STBS is a very limited set of benefits related to your pregnancy.

- STBS does not have the same benefits as SoonerCare.
- STBS covers prenatal care (pregnancy visits) and the delivery of your baby.
- It does not include health benefits for you.

If you would like to apply for health care coverage for yourself, you may apply to the Health Insurance Marketplace. For more information about the Marketplace, please call 1-800-318-2596 or visit <a href="https://www.healthcare.gov">www.healthcare.gov</a>.

We have included a page of some of the services offered under the STBS program. Please read the information as it is very **important** that you understand the benefits. Some services may not be covered by STBS.

## Important Information about Soon-to-be Sooners Services

Below is important information about pregnancy services you may need for the healthiest pregnancy possible.

### Services that you can get

- ✓ Routine office visits related to the baby prenatal care
- ✓ Pregnancy related medications
- ✓ Two ultra sounds during pregnancy; additional ultrasounds are approved when medically necessary
- ✓ Lab services related to the pregnancy
- ✓ Some specialty services when it impacts the baby (requires medical approval)
- ✓ Hospital services for the baby delivery services only

#### **Additional Program Information**

- ✓ You may see any SoonerCare doctor who provides pregnancy care.
- ✓ Not all services are covered. If you have a question about what services are covered for the baby call the SoonerCare Helpline.
- ✓ A white SoonerCare card should have come in your mail. If you did not get a card, call the SoonerCare Helpline to order a new one. You will need it when you go to your doctor or pharmacy. It looks the same as a SoonerCare card, but again, you do not have full SoonerCare.
- ✓ If you move or change your phone number, please update your file at mysoonercare.org or call the SoonerCare Helpline at 1-800-987-7767.
- √ Help to stop smoking if you smoke. (1-800-784-8869 English/1-800-793-1552 Spanish)
- ✓ Free messages on your cell phone to help you through your pregnancy and your baby's first year. You can text BABY to 511411 or go to www.text4baby.org
- ✓ If you deliver at an Oklahoma hospital, the hospital should enroll your baby with SoonerCare. You should receive this information in your discharge papers.
- ✓ After your baby is born or your pregnancy has ended, you no longer qualify for STBS.

#### Services that are not covered

- Services to treat you for conditions that have no relationship to the well-being of the baby
- Prenatal Dental Services
- Non-Emergency Transportation (SoonerRide)
- Vision Services
