



Below is a checklist for medical marijuana businesses that includes common permits, licenses, registrations and/or reminders from other regulatory entities. The information below is not exhaustive and serves only as a compliance and regulatory resource.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Growers, processors, dispensaries, labs and researchers need to register with the <a href="#">Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs</a> (OBNDD).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Activate an account in <a href="#">Metrc</a> . Update Metrc tags to match new OMMA license number, if applicable.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Dispensaries and processors need a tax permit from the <a href="#">Oklahoma Tax Commission</a> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	A <a href="#">Class VIII Un-Odorized LPG Permit</a> from the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Administration (LP Gas) if you use or plan to use any propane or butane gas for extraction.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<a href="#">Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry</a> (ODAFF) license if you plan to sell seeds or clones/live plants. Please read the <a href="#">Nursery, Seed, and Weights and Measurements Programs FAQ page</a> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Outdoor growers must register with <a href="#">Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry</a> (ODAFF) as a sensitive crop. For instructions, <a href="#">click here</a> . For support, please contact <a href="mailto:sensitivecrop@ag.ok.gov">sensitivecrop@ag.ok.gov</a> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Dispensaries and processors need a food license through the <a href="#">Oklahoma State Department of Health</a> (OSDH) if producing or selling edible medical marijuana products.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A permit from the <a href="#">Oklahoma Water Resources Board</a> (OWRB) for uses related to agriculture, irrigation, water supply, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	If located outside of municipal limits, contact the rural water district serving the area to see if water service is available. The <a href="#">Oklahoma Rural Water Association</a> can help you locate contact information for the district.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Submit the <a href="#">foreign financial interest attestation</a> within 60 days of license approval. Businesses must submit one attestation for each commercial license.
