Whereas, the City Council at its February Meeting directed the procedure for such an election be initiated; and



2. That public notices of such election be printed once in The Putnam City-Northwest News, a newspaper of general circulation within the City, beginning on the 17th. day of March, 1977, and establishing a deadline of the 27th. day of March, 1977, for all interested parties who may qualify as an Intervenor, as established by the laws and rules and regulations of the State Public Employees Relations Board to file with said Board in order to appear on said ballot.
3. That the State-Public Employees Relations Board and its Chairman are designated and authorized to conduct such election pursuant to its rules and to certify the election results.
4. That the City of Warr Acres shall be responsible for half of the cost of such actual election with the petitioners to be responsible for the remaining half of actual election costs.
5. That by reason of the need for an immediate implementation of the election for the preservation of peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be effective and take effect immediately upon its adoption.
