Jobless rates up over the year for most Oklahoma counties in March

In March, **McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 5.4 percent. **Seminole County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Haskell County**. **Dewey County** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.8 percent in March. Unemployment rates in March were higher than a year earlier in 53 counties, lower in 14 counties and unchanged in 10 counties.


