In May, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.3 percent. **McIntosh County** reported the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Pittsburg County**. **Beaver** and **Cimarron Counties** reported the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.5 percent in May. Unemployment rates in May were lower than a year earlier in all of Oklahoma's 77 counties.


