²Self-employed & unpaid family workers data are produced from the projection matrix system based on Oklahoma OES (Occupational Employment Statistics) survey and BLS Current Population Survey. The estimates of the number of self-employed in the base year are larger this projections round than they were in previous rounds because the file supplied by the Bureau of Labor Statistics now includes estimates of all self-employed jobs (jobs held by people primarily self-employed plus jobs held by people secondarily self-employed).
