ODVA AND OKLAHOMA VETERANS COMMISSION COMMEND OKLAHOMA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON HB 3693

(OKLAHOMA CITY) – The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs and the Oklahoma Veterans Commission would like to commend the Oklahoma House of Representatives for passage of House Bill 3693 on March 21, 2022. This measure will fully exempt military retired pay from state income taxation in Oklahoma and, when enacted, will demonstrate that in Oklahoma, taking care of Veterans truly is at the forefront of our priorities.
