## Ideas for Creating a Tree of Life in the PSAP:

Next time you grocery shopping ask for paper not plastic bags, or ask for if you can take some with you. You can cut the bag and use it to make the tree and branches - or just the trunk and bring in branches that have fallen off the tree. Print out leaves on colorful paper or cut shapes out of construction paper for the leaves.

## Small center:

- grab a old branch and hang some leaves from a string
- pinch the leaves to the string with clothespins
- Hang a string on the wall and string leaves from it
- Have the leaves and a marker/pen in a basket so people can grab a leaf easily and quickly post a recognition to the tree.
