Re: Request for Attorney General Opinion

Dear Attorney General Pruitt,

On June 6, 2016, Governor Fallin signed SB424 which amends Title 37 O.S. § 521(A). This measure will become effective August 26, 2016. In part, SB424 states that an Oklahoma brewer license authorizes the holder thereof "to sell beer produced by the licensee to consumers twenty-one (21) years of age or older on the premises of the brewery."

Pursuant to 74 O.S. §18b, I respectfully request an Attorney General opinion on the following issues of law:

- 1. Does SB424 allow a brewer licensee to sell beer it produces to consumers twenty-one (21) years of age or older for consumption by that consumer on the licensed premises?
- 2. Does SB424 allow a brewer licensee to sell beer it produces to consumers twenty-one (21) years of age or older for consumption by that consumer off of the licensed premises?
