NATURAL DISASTER EXCEPTION

Guaranty Abstract Company of McClain County, Inc. will charge only \$150.00 for preliminary abstract for any homeowner who sustains a material loss or damage to their home by reason of any natural disaster, including, but not limited to tornadoes, wild fires, or flooding of lakes, any natural disaster, including, but not limited to tornadoes, wild fires, or flooding of lakes, creeks or rivers that overflow their banks because of rain.
