1. An Architect shall be required to plan, design, and prepare plans and specifications for all Code Use Groups as defined by the current International Building Code.
2. A Licensed Interior Designer may be hired for nonstructural interior construction projects in Code Use Groups requiring an Architect.
3. The Board shall waive all fees, penalties, and continuing education, if applicable, during the time licensees are called to active military duty in the armed forces of the United States.
4. An Architect is required for all upgrades, repairs, replacements, and changes in code use groups found in this title requiring an architect.
5. A Licensed Interior Designer may work within their scope of practice in code use group A-1 Assembly.
6. A Landscape Architect can coordinate any elements of technical submissions prepared by others in connection with the design and layout of roadways.
7. Prototypical plans are considered technical submissions.
8. Based upon the information and inquiries made during an investigation, the Investigation Committee may refer all matters directly to the Board.
9. The noncompliance CE reinstatement penalty fee is \$1000.00.
10. All licensees who are 65 years of age or older and retired from active practice are eligible for Emeritus Status.
11. A Licensee or Entity may accept compensation from material or equipment supplier in return for specifying or endorsing their products.
12. Any person or entity who has been determined by the Board to have violated any provision of the State Architectural and Licensed Interior Designers Act or any rule may be fined a maximum civil penalty of \$5000.00.
13. Only Architects and Landscape Architects are permitted to prepare and submitechnical submissions.
14. The construction, addition, or alteration of a building in code use group H – High hazard requires a licensed architect.
