1. Call Meeting to Order

Action Taken: Dr. Blick called the meeting to order at approximately 10:00 a.m. Roll was taken; six members were present representing a quorum.

3. Welcome newly appointed Board members to first in-person meeting

5. Director's Report

Director Joshua Smith welcomed the Board to the meeting and thanked them for their continued support in the agency's mission. He then updated the Board on the agency's goal for Fiscal Year 2022. Beginning with the roll out of and migration of the new asset management software Asset Panda Cloud. He let the Board know we are working towards virtualizing the COBRA proxy computer to enable BOT staff to remote into our COBRA server offsite and we are working with Oklahoma Interactive to finish correcting our breath testing permit acquisitioning process and permit database. He continued with telling the Board we are striving to host BOT records online for self-serve open record fulfillment. Online records will be limited to non-invasive documents such as instrument maintenance records and other records that don't broadly publish vital personal information and the agency will still fulfill open records requests submitted by all parties. He completed his director's report with announcing Vince Barnard's retirement scheduled to be effective June 1, 2022.

10. 2019 State Audit findings from Director and possible action request for the opinion from the Attorney General's Office

Director Joshua Smith explained to the Board that after reviewing the 2019 State Audit findings we had updated and created internal policy and procedures to be in compliance with the findings. He explained to the Board one of the findings from the audit was the Board of Tests is a self-sustaining agency and has failed to transfer the required 10% of fees collected to the state general fund per 62 O.S. § 211. BOT disputed the finding that it is "a self-sustaining board" subject to § 211 since 2003 BOT has received pass-through appropriation funding averaging approximately \$300,000 annually from the Department of Public Safety pursuant to 47 O.S. § 759(A). Director Joshua Smith requested the Board order him to submit the drafted request to the Attorney General's Office for an opinion on this matter.

Action Taken: Chief Michael Bell motioned to accept the letter as written and order Director Joshua Smith to proceed, Earl Morrison seconded the motion
