1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Action Taken: Kevin Kramer called the meeting to order at approximately 10:00 a.m. Roll was taken; five members were present. Sheriff Deveraux appeared shortly after increasing presence to six.

2. Statement of Compliance with the Open Meetings Act

Action Taken: Kevin Kramer gave statement of compliance for the record.

4. Director's Report

The Director provided the following updates:

FY25 Budget and Purchase Orders: Jordan and the Director sat down and created the budget for FY25, the budget increased approximately 10K to cover salary increases awarded to all employees except the Director in May 2024 totaling \$771K. Jordan has completed setting up the FY25 Purchase Orders and she has increased her knowledge in this area due to some failures experienced with OMES. The Director expressed he was very pleased with her skills in managing the agency's business activities.

IDAP: Agency continues to show steady growth in the program. It appears the average amount of enrollments is around 200 per month. The agency started our new GALT employee, Linda Frieden on July 1st, 2024. She has been a great help and she is doing well with learning the IDAP processes. The Director reported they are currently working on increasing her data entry accuracy.

May – 199 June – 188 July – 221

Training: David will have completed 41 Intoxilyzer 8000 courses by the end of August. Since David took action to notify leadership at agencies regarding no shows to our classes, he has experienced a positive response to the notices.

Maintenance: The agency continues to maintain instrumentation the best we can. We currently have 18 units at CMI awaiting repair. Average repair times are between 90 and 120 days.

Agency Move Update\Progress: DPS began renovating the area across the street in building 1. The timeline for availability is tentatively reported as 1st quarter of 2025. We have received some encouraging updates from the construction crew. When more concrete dates are being discussed, the Board will be notified. No move may occur lawfully until the Board has approved the move in an open meeting.

Grant Updates: Units received - 10; Oklahoma Software/Firmware Document has had its last review and we await receipt of the edits to sign off on and development will be queued with the CMI software engineers.

5. Discussion and possible action to adopt proposed emergency* rules to be effective November 1, 2024, in response to HB3000 statutory changes signed into law during the 2024 Legislative Session.

- e. 40:50-3-5 Program completion, violations, and failure criteria for participants enrolled on or after November 1, 2022 [AMENDED]
