Method Used to Conduct Review: Rules were reviewed against current programs, established procedures and the statutes that established each of the agency programs. Our program rules are evaluated as program revisions are necessary to best meet the changing rural health climate and market needs. Current emergency rules changes are in effect for Title 540: Chapters 35,40, 45 and 50 rules with permanent changes to follow. The changes are to revise the current nursing, physician and physician assistant programs to meet the current healthcare needs.
