

Oklahoma Adult Basic Education / High School Equivalency

In the state of Oklahoma, there are two tests that can be taken to attain a high school equivalency diploma. Since 2014, an eligible individual can take the GED test and the HiSET test.

Those who pass one of the two approved tests will receive the state's official high school equivalency diploma, a credential issued by the Oklahoma Department of Education.

** You do not need to attend preparation classes in order to take one of the below tests. It is highly recommended, but it is not required.

The two tests that are allowed in Oklahoma are:

GED

- Test Format: Computer-Based
- Cost: \$136 Full Battery
- Receipt of Scores: Online scores returned within 24 hours of completing each module.
- You can register to take the GED test or take official practice tests at <https://ged.com/> and click on the “sign up” button in the top right of the window.

HiSET

- Test Format: Paper and / or Computer-Based
- Cost: \$122.50 Full Battery / Paper Based \$101.25 Full Battery / Computer Based
- Receipt of Scores: On average, official scores are available within 3–5 business days for multiple-choice tests and 6–10 business days for essay tests. Immediate, unofficial scores for computer-delivered tests are displayed at the test center upon completion.

***Payment for the test(s) must be made online at time of registration.**

Oklahoma HSE Option

- Any Oklahoma Resident who has been admitted to any accredited Oklahoma college or university may be awarded a high school diploma by the State Department of Education within this state, provided that such person has successfully completed at least thirty (30) hours of college work at an accredited college or university.



Who is eligible to take an HSE test?

Test takers must meet the following criteria:

- Not currently enrolled in high school
- Not graduated from high school
- At least 16 years old
- If you are 16 or 17 years of age, you must complete the 16/17 Release Form and submit the completed form to the test center before scheduling your exam.

Residency:

You do not have to be a resident of Oklahoma to take the HiSET or GED exam.

Identification

You must present a government-issued ID on test day at the test center. Outdated or expired ID will not be accepted.

Acceptable ID includes:

- A valid driver's license
- A valid state-issued picture identification card
- Passport
- Military ID
- Other forms of national or foreign government ID

Practice Tests

Both test vendors offer practice exams which can be downloaded on their website. Some have a cost and some are free.
