



ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR OKLAHOMA CAREER READINESS DIPLOMA

To satisfy the academic requirements for the Oklahoma Career Readiness Diploma, students must meet at least one of the criteria outlined below for each of the five content areas.

Note: *High school credit requirements may change based on updated graduation guidelines. If you are using high school credits to meet subject area requirements, your transcripts must reflect the necessary credits.*

MATHEMATICS

Math credit may be earned by achieving one of the following:

- High School Credit (3 Units of Approved Coursework)
- GED Math (Minimum Score – 145)
- HiSET Math (Minimum Score – 8)
- TABE Math (Minimum Score – 537)

High school transcripts must satisfy the Math credit requirement.

SCIENCE

Science credit may be earned by achieving one of the following:

- High School Credit (3 Units of Approved Coursework)
- GED Science (Minimum Score – 145)
- HiSET Science (Minimum Score – 8)

High school transcripts must satisfy the Science credit requirement

SOCIAL STUDIES

Social Studies credit may be earned by achieving one of the following:

- High School Credit (3 Units of Approved Coursework)
- GED Social Studies (Minimum Score – 145)
- HiSET Social Studies (Minimum Score – 8)

High school transcripts must satisfy the Social Studies / History credit requirement.

LANGUAGE ARTS - READING

Language Arts Reading credit may be earned by achieving one of the following:

- High School Credit (4 Units of Approved Coursework)
- GED Language Arts (Minimum Score – 145)
- HiSET Language Arts (Minimum Score – 8)
- TABE – Reading (Minimum Score – 536)

High school transcripts must satisfy the English credit requirement.

LANGUAGE ARTS - WRITING

Language Arts Writing credit may be earned by achieving one of the following:

- High School Credit (4 Units of Approved Coursework)
- HiSET Writing (Minimum Score – 8 multiple choice / 2 essay)
- GED Language Arts (Minimum Score – 145)

High school transcripts must satisfy the English credit requirement.
