Registration and Costs

1. EARLY-registration is at Judging Card until March 18th, 2024

 - Cost of entry at judgingcard.com for **PRE-REGISTER by March 18th** is \$20.00 for teams and \$7.00 per extra individuals.

2. LATE Registration from March 19th to March 27th, 2024
 - Teams needing to PRE-register **after** March 18th but by March 27th, you will need to LATE REGISTER online at judgingcard.com. If you register **AFTER MARCH 18, 2024 but by March 27th**, the cost for ALL contests is \$35.00 per team and/or \$12.00 per individual. Register at [Judgingcard.com](https://www.judgingcard.com)
3. PROCRASTINATION registration is from March 28 to April 2nd, 2024

 - **TEAMS NEEDING TO LATE REGISTER AFTER** March 27 and up to the April 2, the cost for all contests is \$100 per team and/or \$30/individual Register at <https://connorsstate.square.site>
4. Day of Contest Registration-Education Building 131 beginning at 7:00 am.
 - ALL Contests will be allowed to register on the day of contest at a cost of \$100/team and/or \$30/Individual in Education Building 131. No changes to livestock entries can be made on the day of contest.
 - All chapters/clubs may; PRE-REGISTER AND LATE ENTER and Procrastination enter and bring multiple teams per contest. However, only the highest ranking team per school will be eligible for team prizes. All points from all teams will be calculated toward sweepstakes.
 - LATE ENTRY Teams will be entered and accepted up through the day of contest until or if we run out of scantrons.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT CHANGES TO THE LIVESTOCK JUDGING ON CONTEST DAY. ONLY NEW REGISTRATIONS for livestock judging teams will be accepted on day of contest. All changes to LJ contest must be completed BEFORE March 27th, 2024

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

All Agricultural Education Chapters and 4-H Clubs in Oklahoma, Arkansas, Texas, Kansas, Missouri, Louisiana, New Mexico, Ohio, and Arizona. Each Agricultural Education Chapter may bring multiple preregistered teams per contest. 4-H Clubs may also pre-enter and compete with multiple teams. However, only the highest performing team from a chapter, club or county is eligible for team awards in each division. All contestants are eligible for individual awards.

CONTEST TIMES

- Livestock judging contest- Packet pickup for registered teams will begin at 7:00 am in the McPeak Hall of Fame. Send one contestant or coach into the Hall of Fame for Packet Pick Up (Pre-registered Teams) All contestants should gather on the south side of the indoor arena, (outside of the building) before the contest. Livestock Judging will begin promptly at 8:00 A.M.
- Main Campus contests will start at 9:00 A.M.
- South Ranch Contests and Warner Event Center Contests will begin at 9:30 A.M. There will be buses provided for all contestants going to the Event Center. Contestants will load on the West side of the Library and register at the Event Center.
- The livestock judging awards will be presented at approximately 2:00 p.m. at the indoor arena. All other awards may be picked up by the instructors in the Melvin Self Field House Multi-Purpose Room as soon as the contests are tabulated and the results are POSTED in Melvin Self Fieldhouse.

LIVESTOCK JUDGING CONTEST

- **Senior Livestock Judging with Oral Reasons** 8th-12th grade for FFA)
- (ages 14 and up for 4-H members) (Will give a minimum of 3 sets of oral reasons)

- **Junior Livestock Judging with Questions** (8th-10th grade only for FFA) (ages 8-13 only for 4-H members) Will answer questions on a minimum of 3 classes of livestock. There are no oral reasons.
- **Placings Only Livestock Judging Individual Contest** (no oral reasons or written questions) (8 years old to 10 grade) Individual contest. This is not a default contest. If you want to enter this division, you must do so during the pre-entry or late entry period; NOT the day of the contest)
- Individuals will be allowed to enter in all contests. Their scores will be calculated and counted toward individual awards.
- American Farmers and Ranchers will be sponsoring the Livestock Judging Contest. They will provide the meal for students.
- Connors will be providing scholarships for the livestock judging awards.
- Alternates, Ag Instructors, Agents, and Adult Leaders will be given time to see the classes **after** the teams have placed them.
- **Only those FFA instructors, agents and 4-H leaders selected as group leaders will be allowed in the contest arena/room.**
