Name	0083 – CLEP – College Algebra
Description	The College Algebra exam covers material that's usually taught in a one-semester college course in algebra. Nearly half the test is made up of routine problems requiring basic algebraic skills; the remainder involves solving nonroutine problems in which test takers must demonstrate their understanding of concepts. The test includes questions on basic algebraic operations; linear and quadratic equations, inequalities, and graphs; algebraic, exponential, and logarithmic functions; and miscellaneous other topics.

## Candidates receiving this certification will take an exam with the following criteria:

The exam contains approximately 60 questions to be answered in 90 minutes. Some of these are pretest questions that won't be scored.

## Criteria

- 1. Algebraic Operations 25%
- 2. Equations and Inequalities 25%
- 3. Functions and their Properties 30%
- 4. Number Systems and Operations 20%
