| Description | The College Algebra exam covers material that's usually <br> taught in a one-semester college course in algebra. Nearly <br> half the test is made up of routine problems requiring basic <br> algebraic skills; the remainder involves solving nonroutine <br> problems in which test takers must demonstrate their <br> understanding of concepts. The test includes questions on <br> basic algebraic operations; linear and quadratic equations, <br> inequalities, and graphs; algebraic, exponential, and <br> logarithmic functions; and miscellaneous other topics. |

The exam contains approximately 60 questions to be answered in 90 minutes. Some of these are pretest questions that won't be scored.
