Description	The assessments measure a student's ability to apply knowledge of the skills necessary for success in the Automotive sector. These assessments are aligned with the 2017 National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE)/National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) standards and endorsed by the Oklahoma Automobile Dealers Association (OADA).
Criteria	 Candidates receiving this certification will take an exam with the following criteria: The exam is composed of 55 questions. 1. Perform General Brake Systems Diagnosis 13% 2. Perform Hydraulic System Diagnosis and Repair 20% 3. Perform Drum Brake Diagnosis and Repair 13% 4. Perform Disc Brake Diagnosis and Repair 20% 5. Perform Power-Assist Units Diagnosis and Repair 9% 6. Perform Miscellaneous (Wheel Bearings, Parking Brakes, Electrical, etc.) Diagnosis and Repair 18% 7. Perform Electronic Brake, Traction and Stability Control Systems Diagnosis and Repair 7%
