Description	The assessments measure a student's ability to apply knowledge of the skills necessary for success in the Automotive sector. These assessments are aligned with the 2017 National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE)/National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) standards and endorsed by the Oklahoma Automobile Dealers Association (OADA).
Criteria	 Candidates receiving this certification will take an exam with the following criteria: The exam is composed of 55 questions. 1. Perform General Engine Diagnosis 33% 2. Perform Computerized Engine Controls Diagnosis and Repair 7% 3. Perform Ignition System Diagnosis and Repair 18% 4. Perform Fuel, Air Induction, and Exhaust Systems Diagnosis and Repair 16% 5. Perform Emissions Control Systems Diagnosis and Repair 26%
