Description	CAM Milling or Computer-Aided Manufacturing. This certification, endorsed by The National Institute for Metalworking Skills, NIMS, measures a candidate's ability to perform multiple operations on CNC milling machines. Earning this credential measures a candidate's ability to apply the knowledge and skills necessary for success in the Machining industry.
Criteria	Candidates receiving this certification will take an exam with the following criteria: The exam is composed of 64 questions. Performance is evaluated by physical setup, machining and verification of parts. Understand design intent from detailed drawings. Create a process plan for machining parts. Create 3D CAD files from 2D drawings. Setups - Milling Create 2D Milling toolpaths. Export supporting documentation and G-code.
