Description	The assessment, endorsed by the National Center for Construction Education and Research NCCER, measures a student's ability to apply the knowledge and skills necessary for success in entry-level cabinetmaking.
Criteria	Candidates receiving this certification will take an exam with the following criteria: This exam is composed of 50 questions • Apply wood veneers and plastic laminates 8% • Assemble, fasten and install components 18% • Cut and shape components 12% • Design and layout 4% • Finish surfaces 6% • Transport and install cabinets 8% • Demonstrate employability skills 4% • Practice power tools and electrical safety 8% • Use measurement skills 4% • Identify commonly used tools, materials, and methods 12%
