Identify and Care for Tack and Equipment 5% 8. Perform General Horse Handling 9% 9. Maintain Horse Nutrition 3% 10.Evaluate Horses 4% 11.Evaluate Equine Genetics 3% 12.Work with the Stallion 4% 13.Work with the Mare 6% 14.Parturition of the Mare 5%
