Description	The certification exam consists of two parts: a clinical skills examination and a written examination. The clinical skills examination consists of several skills that AUAs perform on the job. Candidates must perform all critical tasks correctly and perform non-critical tasks with 80% accuracy in order to pass the clinical skills exam. In order to pass the written examination, candidates must score 70% or higher
Criteria	 Candidates receiving this certification will take an exam with the following criteria: The exam is composed of 50 questions. Understand the Role of the Advanced Unlicensed Assistant — 20% (10 questions) Demonstrate Mastery of Basic Medical Knowledge and Skills — 8% (4 questions) Follow Basic Safety and Infection Control Guidelines — 18% (9 questions) Demonstrate Asepsis and Sterile Technique — 14% (7 questions) Provide General Circulatory Care and Maintenance — 10% (5 questions) Provide Care to Maintain Digestion/Elimination — 10% (5 questions) Provide Care to Maintain Urinary Elimination — 8% (4 questions) Provide Respiratory Care — 12% (6 questions)
