Draw blood from patients and blood donors Evaluate patients' ability to withstand procedure Explain blood-drawing procedure to patients and answer questions Perform basic point of care testing, such as blood glucose levels Prepare blood, urine and other specimens for testing Verify patient/donor identity Maintain medical equipment such as needles, test tubes and blood vials
