<b>Criteria</b>	<p><b><i>Candidates receiving this certification will take an exam with the following criteria:</i></b></p> <p>The exam is composed of 100 questions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Draw blood from patients and blood donors</li><li>• Evaluate patients' ability to withstand procedure</li><li>• Explain blood-drawing procedure to patients and answer questions</li><li>• Perform basic point of care testing, such as blood glucose levels</li><li>• Prepare blood, urine and other specimens for testing</li><li>• Verify patient/donor identity</li><li>• Maintain medical equipment such as needles, test tubes and blood vials</li></ul>
