





Oklahoma's Promise allows eighth-, ninth-, 10th- and 11th-grade students from families meeting certain income requirements to earn a college or technology center tuition scholarship. Students must also meet academic and conduct requirements in high school.



# **Application Requirements**

- Student must currently be attending the 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade
- □ Income limit at the time of application
  - □ \$60K with 1-2 dependent children
  - □ \$70K with 3-4 dependent children
  - □ \$80K with 5 or more dependent children
- Must be an Oklahoma resident
- □ Deadline for the 2024-2025 school year: June 30, 2025
- □ December 31 of the student's senior year (prior to graduation) is the deadline for the income documentation for the incomplete application



#### APPLICATION/AGREEMENT FORM



Mail this application plus the required documentation to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education using the attached envelope. The application must be postmarked on or before **JUNE 30, 2025** (homeschool applications must be postmarked before the student's 17th birthday).

Following the receipt of the application, a letter confirming enrollment or requesting more information will be mailed to the student's home from the State Regents' office.

# **Updated Enrollment Guidelines** for Students in DHS Custody

- □ Students in DHS custody can apply with documentation from DHS in the eighth, ninth, 10th or 11th grade (this is the same as it has been in the past).
- □ NEW: Students who are <u>placed</u> in DHS custody during the 8th, 9th, 10th or 11th grade can apply for Oklahoma's Promise during the 12th grade prior to high school graduation if they were not previously enrolled.



## **Scholarship Benefits**

- □ If the student meets the requirements and completes the 15-unit curriculum, Oklahoma's Promise will cover tuition at an Oklahoma public or a portion at an eligible private college, **and** at an Oklahoma public technology center (eligible programs). The scholarship excludes fees, books, supplies, and room and board.
- ☐ If a student completes HS graduation requirements, they could be eligible for a scholarship to be used **only** at a career technology center only. With this pathway, a student would not be eligible to transfer it to a college/university.
- There is a second income limit of \$100K when the student starts their college/career education.



# **Scholarship Benefits (continued)**

- Oklahoma's Promise updates the scholarship rates for each institution every academic year which is available on the OKP website.
- A student has 3 years after high school graduation to enroll and attend a post-secondary institution in order to be eligible for the scholarship.
- Oklahoma's Promise eligibility has a limit of 5 years OR 129 credit hours OR the completion of a Bachelor's degree, whichever comes first.
