SUBJECT: Request for Proposals
FY24 (2023-2024) Competitive Technology Center Lottery Grants

This year, the Technology Lottery Grant Committee is offering both a *Noncompetitive* and *Competitive* Request for Proposals (RFP). Attached are the documents associated with the Technology Center Lottery Grant **Competitive Grant** call for proposals: the RFP, Proposal Application, Reviewer's Rubric, and Budget Request Form. The deadline for e-mail submission for this grant is March 2, 2023.

The four sections of each application must be submitted as one PDFed document and in this order: Letter of Support and Sustainability signed by the superintendent and on school letterhead, Proposal Application, Budget Request Form, and any supplemental documentation requested in the RFP.

Each of Oklahoma's 29 technology centers may only apply for one Competitive Technology Center Lottery Grant per district. Note that a technology center district may apply for a Competitive Lottery Grant, regardless of whether they are eligible for a Noncompetitive Technology Center Lottery Grant this year or not.
