# **Keynote Speaker**



Virginia Wangerin, PhD, RN, CNE

Dr. Virginia "Ginny" Wangerin is an educator, consultant, and speaker with over 40 years' experience in nursing. She has taught at the ADN, BSN and graduate level, and most recently developed and implemented the first nursing program at Iowa State University. Dr. Wangerin is recognized as a lifelong leader and nursing advocate, serving on numerous committees and boards, advocating for the profession and at-risk populations. She was profiled in "The American Nurse" as a nurse educator and advocate whose "efforts are aimed at improving the lives of patients and colleagues." She was honored by the Iowa Nurses Association with the Edith Ruppert Award, in recognition of having contributed significantly to the improvement of nursing and the professional organization. As a nurse education leader, she has developed and implemented concurrent enrollment programs and conceptbased curriculum. Dr. Wangerin is a consultant and speaker for accreditation, curriculum development, learning strategies and outcomes assessment, and leadership development.




#### Directions:
