The students responded to a mock accident with the assistance of The Chickasaw Nation, Stephens County, the city of Duncan, Duncan Fire Department, Duncan Police Department, Survival Flight, Tri County Wrecking and Sellers Savage, all of which provided equipment and personnel, according to *The Duncan Banner*.
