### FINAL ORDER

On the 16th day of July, 2004 the Oklahoma State Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board) heard the above styled and numbered administrative action. Members Carder, and Gardner were present. President Tripp presided. Ms. P.K. Floyd prosecuted for the Board. The Respondent did not appear and was not represented by Counsel. The Board heard witnesses, received evidence and was fully apprised of the facts and allegations.

The Complaint in the instant matter is hereby incorporated by reference.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- Respondent holds license # 3466 issued by the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
- 2. Respondent has failed to renew his license to practice chiropractic for the year 2005.

- 3. Respondent has failed to post a current renewal license in a prominent place at the primary location where he is engaged in the practice of chiropractic.
- 4. Respondent failed to complete sixteen (16) hours of continuing education in calendar year 2004.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action pursuant to 59 O.S.2001, §§161.11-161.12.
- 2. Any Finding of Fact, which is properly a Conclusion of Law is hereby incorporated by reference and vice versa.
- 3. Respondent has violated 59 O.S.2001, §161.11(A) by failing to renew his license, as set forth in the First Allegation of the Complaint.
- 4. Respondent has violated OAC 140:15-7-1 by failing to post a current renewal license in a prominent place at the primary location where he is engaged in the practice of chiropractic, as set forth in the Second Allegation of the Complaint.
- 5. Respondent has violated 59 O.S.2001, §161.11(A) by failing to complete sixteen (16) hours of continuing education in calendar year 2004, as set forth in the Third Allegation of the Complaint.
- 6. Based on the above Findings of Fact, the Board has authority to suspend the Respondent's license pursuant to 59 O.S.2001, §161.11(D) and 59 O.S.2001, §161.12(A)(2).

## **ORDER**

- 1. Respondent is guilty of all three allegations as set forth in the Complaint.
- 2. Respondent's license is hereby suspended.
