

The following information has been provided to us from a licensed chiropractic physician that the Oklahoma Department of Health does not mail reminders for renewing the X-ray license. Below is information on how to process your renewal of your X-ray license. If you have additional questions, we encourage you to reach out to the Oklahoma Department of Health.

Dear License Holder,

We are writing to inform you of an important update to the State Health Department's licensing process.

As part of our efforts to improve efficiency and provide a more streamlined experience, we have transitioned to a new online licensing database. This system will be used for all license renewals moving forward.

What does this mean for you:

You will need to register for an online account in order for us to link your current licenses for you to have access to your permits and process your renewals online.

What do you need to do:

1. Visit the new online licensing portal: [Oklahoma State Department of Health Consumer Health Service](#)
2. Select Business Licensing followed by Register for an Account. You will get a temporary password emailed to you. **Once logged into the portal you do not need to create a business. 3. Email CHSLicensing@Health.ok.gov What email you registered and what license number (or numbers) you need to have linked to your account.

Once this is complete, you will be able to see your licenses on the portal, receive renewal notifications, and apply for licensing via the portal.
