MECHANICAL APPLICATION INFORMATION

Fueled Hearth Product Work

All applicants must be eighteen (18) years of age or older

"Fueled Hearth Product Work" means the installation, service or repair of biomass-fueled or natural gas-fired fireplace, fireplace insert, stove or log set and associated venting and piping that fuels or simulates a flame of a solid fuel fire, including accessories for use with natural gas. This does not include (a) gas piping work, (b) the servicing of gas piping, or (c) work associated with pressure regulating devices, except for factory installed appliance gas valves.

FEES - MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION:

Make remittance payable to the CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRIES BOARD (CIB)

Mechanical Contractor (License \$300.00 + Processing \$30.00 = total \$330.00)

Mechanical Journeyman (License \$50.00 + Processing \$25.00 = total \$75.00)

JOURNEYMAN:

Provide proof of NFI examination in the certification categories of gas, wood or pellets.

CONTRACTORS EXAMINATION INFORMATION AND MATERIAL FOR STUDY:

All applicants are required to provide proof of NFI examination in the certification categories of gas, wood or pellets. In addition, Contractors must take and pass the Mechanical Business and Law exam or otherwise demonstrate minimum competency in business operations by any three (3) from the below listed items:

- i. Registration with the Oklahoma Secretary of State for the last five (5) years,
- ii. A letter (stating the specific professional service has been provided to the hearth product installation business of the Contractor applicant for a period of at least five (5) years) from a professional service provider used by your business including those who: prepare taxes, payroll, financial statements, provide legal services, banking, risk management or other professional services provided to your business,
- iii. Satisfactory proof of filing state business taxes for the last five (5) years,
- iv. Satisfactory proof of business entity filing with another state agency or registered business,
- v. Satisfactory proof of business operations for the last five (5) years such as bidding, estimating, quoting, contract/project management.

Once the Construction Industries Board receives your application and remittance, it will be reviewed for approval. Once approved you will receive a letter stating your application has been approved and your information will be forwarded to our national testing provider PSI for testing. You are responsible for contacting PSI to schedule an appointment to take the Contractors Business and Law exam by calling 800-733-9267 or via the internet at www.psiexams.com. Contact PSI for study materials, testing sites, testing fees and testing dates or download the Candidate Information Bulletin from their website.

Any applicant initially failing to pass the examination shall not be permitted to take another examination for a period of thirty (30) days. Any applicant subsequently failing to pass the examination shall not be permitted to take another examination for a period of ninety (90) days.

CONTRACTORS:

After you have successfully passed all appropriate exams, your license will be inactive until the CIB receives proof of the bond and insurance listed below:

- 1. An Active Mechanical Contractor is required to carry a five thousand dollar (\$5,000.00) Corporate Surety Bond payable to the Oklahoma Construction Industries Board. *The bond must be in the individual license holder's name*. The bond must be continuous and provide for thirty- (30) days cancellation notice.
- 2. An Active Mechanical Contractor must provide a certificate of insurance evidencing a minimum of \$50,000.00 commercial general liability insurance. *The individual license holder's name must be on the certificate of insurance.* The certificate holder is the Construction Industries Board.

CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS (CONTRACTORS & JOURNEYMAN):
