

# Internet Crimes Against Children: Basic CyberTip Investigations

This course is designed to be an introduction to the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force. It will introduce participants to the task force, and provide an overview of its structure and operations. Students will learn investigative techniques for CyberTip reports submitted by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children.



Topics will include:

- Origins of the ICAC Task Force
- Introduction to the ICAC Data System
- Search Warrants for electronic service providers
- Interview/interrogation tips for ICAC offenders
- Case Studies

**ICAC cases familiarize investigators with modern technology, websites, and applications. The ICAC investigator will also become comfortable with writing search warrants for electronic service providers, electronic devices, and residences. These tools are extremely valuable in all criminal cases, not just those involving child sexual abuse material (CSAM).**
