This course is designed to help pro-active patrol officers develop safe and effective enforcement programs. The goal is to fill the void left by many interdiction classes by focusing on officer safety and tactics, de-escalatory communication, and learning to place value on behavior consistent with criminal activity and threats to the officer. Students will be given instruction and multiple video examples to help them recognize and defeat active countermeasures employed by criminals to avoid detection.

- make a good video/talk to your camera
- de-escalatory communication
- recognize criminal behavior, don't cause it
- statement analysis/tactical communication
- identifying active counter measures
- articulating reasonable suspicion
- tactics for dealing with multiple occupants
- expanding the scope
- tactics for detention
- vehicle searches
- defeating basic concealment methods
- documenting evidence
- report writing
- courtroom testimony
