DEVELOPED BY NAEMT, PRE-HOSPITAL TRAUMA LIFE SUPPORT (PHTLS) COMMITTEE, THIS PROGRAM IS BASED ON GUIDELINES ON TACTICAL EMERGENCY CASUALTY CARE (TECC). TECC USES LESSONS LEARNED FROM THE MILITARY AND APPLIES IT TO THE CIVILIAN WORLD OF TACTICAL MEDICINE. THIS 20-HOUR, 3-DAY COURSE COVERS TOPICS DESIGNED TO DECREASE PREVENTABLE DEATH IN A TACTICAL SITUATION.

- CLASSROOM COVERS TOPICS SUCH AS DIRECT, INDIRECT, AND EVACUATION CARE.
- SKILLS COVERED ARE HEMORRHAGE AND AIRWAY CONTROL AS WELL AS STRATEGIES FOR TREATING WOUND WHILE IN THREATENING SITUATIONS. WE WILL ALSO COVER LIFTING, DRAGGING, AND CARRYING VICTIMS AS WELL AS THE "MARCH" ASSESSMENT.

SCENARIOS FOR THE TECC FINAL EXERCISE WILL UTILIZE SIMULATED/ REALISTIC TRAINING METHODS INCLUDING PYROTECHNICS, SPECIAL EFFECTS MAKEUP, ROLE PLAYERS AND MEDICAL SIMULATION DEVICES. SCENARIOS ARE DEVELOPED TO CLOSELY REPLICATE REAL WORLD EVENTS INCLUDING AIR-SOFT TECHNOLOGY.
